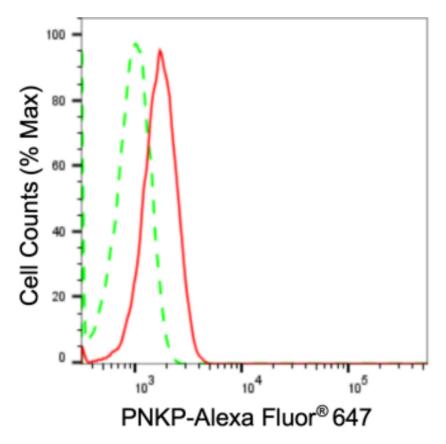

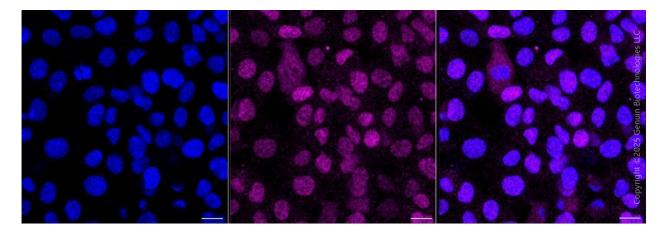

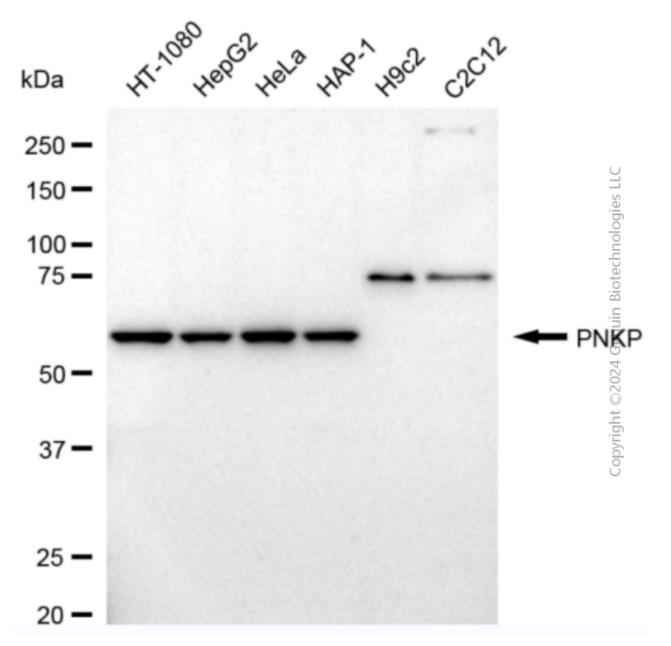

Western blotting analysis using anti-PNKP antibody (Cat#2464). Total cell lysates (30 μg) from various cell lines were loaded and separated by SDS-PAGE. The blot was incubated with anti-PNKP antibody (Cat#2464, 1:5,000) and HRP-conjugated goat anti-rabbit secondary antibody (Cat#201, 1:20,000) respectively. Image was developed using FeQ<sup>TM</sup> ECL Substrate Kit (Cat#226).
