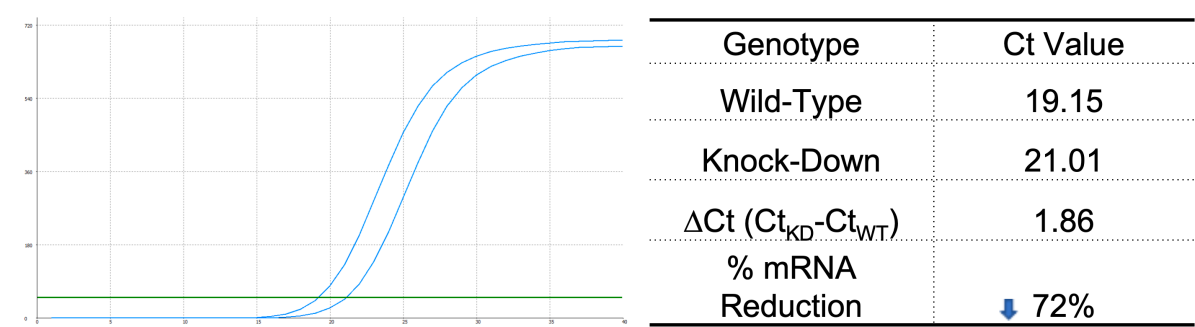

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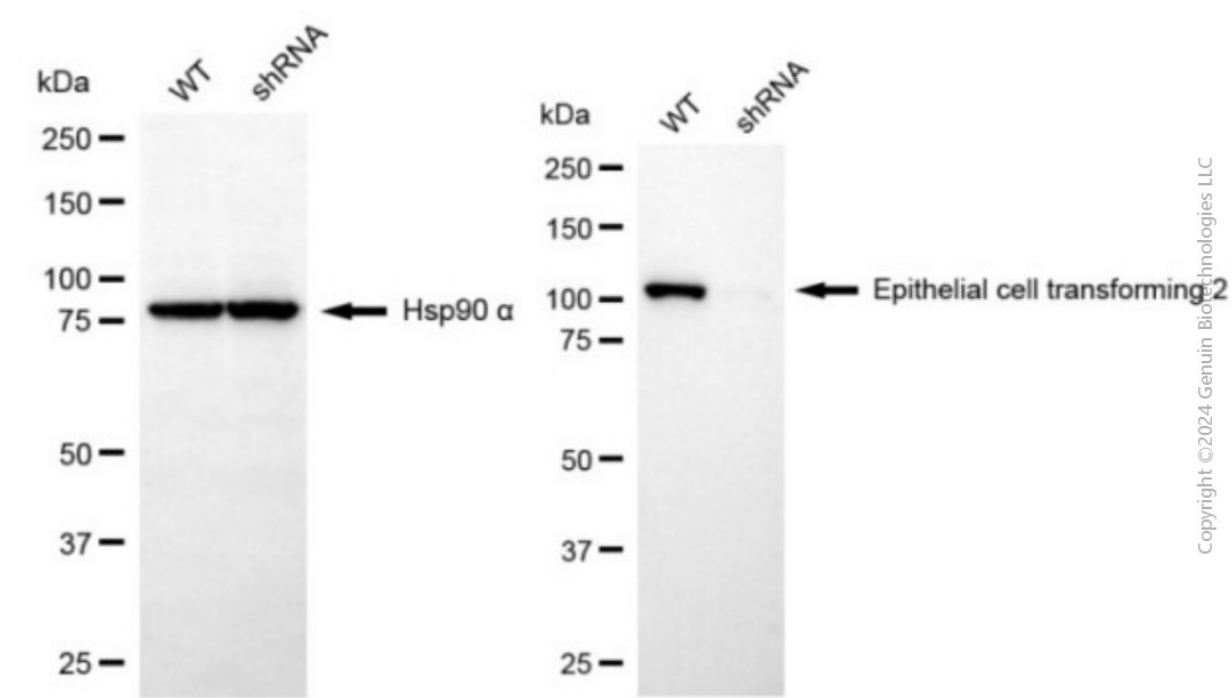
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RT-qPCR analysis. HeLa cells were infected with ECT2-specific shRNA lentiviral particles, total RNA was extracted from wild-type and knockdown cells, RT-qPCR was performed using gene-specific primers. $\Delta Ct (Ct_{KD} - Ct_{WT})$ was used to calculate mRNA reduction (%) between wild-type and knockdown cells using the following formula: $(1 - 1/2^{\Delta Ct}) \times 100\%$.



Western blotting analysis. ECT2 protein expression in wild-type (WT) and shRNA knockdown (KD) HeLa cells was detected using Western blotting. Hsp90 α served as a loading control. The blots were incubated with primary antibodies against ECT2 and Hsp90 α , respectively, followed by incubating with HRP-conjugated goat anti-mouse secondary antibody. Images were developed using FeQ™ ECL Substrate Kit.
