

Recombinant multi-tag protein (5 ng) in E. coli were loaded and separated by SDS-PAGE. The blot was incubated with anti-Flag tag antibody (Cat#T025, 1:5,000) and HRP-conjugated goat anti-rabbit secondary antibody (Cat#201, 1:20,000) respectively. Image was developed using NaQTM ECL Substrate Kit (Cat#716).
